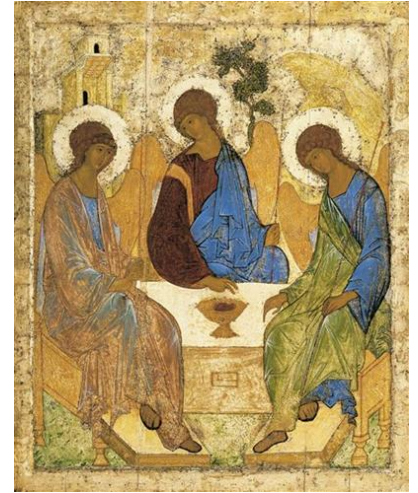

It depicts the three angels who visited Abraham at the Oak of Mamre Genesis 18:1–8, one of my favourite readings.
